Paper Bag Kite Craft

Supplies Needed for Paper Bag Kites

- paper lunch bags
- yarn or strong twine/string
- popsicle stick
- scissors
- streamers
- tape
- scissors
- Optional: stickers, paint, markers, crayons, construction paper, washi tape



Directions

To get started, you can decorate the paper bags using a variety of embellishments. Stickers and washi tape work really well to add some fun prints and colors! You could also draw designs with markers and crayons or add polka dots and stripes using washable paints. Just make sure the paint is dry before moving on to the next step.

Using a pair of scissors, snip a little hole on the bottom base of the bag. This will be used for the kite string.

Cut a piece of yarn or string about 20-24 inches long. Tie one end to the middle of a popsicle stick and feed the other end through the hole in the bag. The popsicle stick will keep the kite string from pulling out when it's flying.



Attach streamers to the open end of the bag using tape. Now the kite is ready to fly!
